**BOAT RACK PERMITS - \$40 for 1<sup>st</sup> permit / \$60.00 for 2<sup>nd</sup> permit**

You may purchase up to two boat rack permits although only one storage spot may be provided. 2<sup>nd</sup> spots will be assigned, if available, in the order in which applications are received.

Permits will be issued to applicants who provide full descriptions, as requested below. This information enables us to assign spots on the rack most effectively. Please note that the racks cannot accommodate vessels of more than 15' in length.

**NOTE: All vessels must be removed from the boat racks on or before December 1<sup>st</sup>. Any vessel remaining on the rack after December 1<sup>st</sup>, will be removed by the Village and removal/storage fees will be imposed pursuant to Section C of the Harbor Rules and Regulations.**

## SECTION C: DINGHY STORAGE

1. Dinghies and other small boats/vessels (including but not limited to kayaks) stored on racks at the village hall must have the current year's sticker attached. Stickers may be purchased by mail. Applications are available at the village hall.
2. The Harbor Master will notify residents by telephone of their assigned dinghy/vessel/small boat space after being notified by the village hall that a sticker has been purchased.
3. The assigned location will depend upon dinghy/vessel/small boat dimensions. Rack location numbers bear no relation to sticker numbers.
4. Boats on racks may not exceed 15 feet in length.
5. Dinghies and small boats/vessels must be properly secured in their assigned rack location at all times.
6. **Dinghies and boats/vessels must be removed from the racks by December 1st and may not be installed before April 15<sup>th</sup>.**
7. The Clerk will provide email notice to the permit holder advising them that the Village will remove, or cause to be removed, any dinghy or other boat / vessel, which is not properly secured in its assigned rack or which is remaining on the rack after December 1st. The resident / permit holder / owner of any dinghy or other boat / vessel so removed shall pay a removal fee of \$200 plus an initial storage fee of \$200. An additional storage fee of \$200 will be charged for each month that the dinghy or other vessel remains unclaimed.

The resident / permit holder / owner of a dinghy or other boat/vessel removed by the Village will not be eligible for new permits, including, but not limited to parking and dinghy permits, unless and until the dinghy or other boat/vessel is redeemed from storage and all removal and storage fees are paid. If the dinghy or other boat/vessel is not redeemed by April 15th of the following boating season it shall be deemed abandoned and the Village may dispose of same without liability. The Village is not responsible for any boat/dinghy or other vessel that it removes, nor shall it be responsible for any dinghy or other boat/vessel while in storage.

Further, the owner of such dinghy or other boat / vessel may be subject to the provisions of Section 140-14 of Chapter 140 entitled "Waterways" of the Code of the Village of Laurel Hollow, ***with a maximum fine of \$1,000. / 15 days imprisonment for each day; each day being a distinct and separate violation.***
